## **Training Guide for North Slope Travel & Work**



This guide outlines the *minimum* training required to travel and work at ConocoPhillips Alaska assets on the North Slope. Training requirements are based on whether personnel are Escorted / Visitors or Unescorted, as defined below. Additional training is necessary depending on the nature of the task being performed. Contact your sponsor, supervisor, or local Safety Specialist if you have any questions about training needs.

Unescorted	Escorted / Visitors
Personnel who travel to the North Slope to perform physical work without being escorted, regardless of location and crew size.	Personnel who travel to the North Slope for various reasons (audit, meeting, tour, etc.) but are not involved with physical work activity are considered visitors. If visitors leave the main camp area, they must be escorted at all times by a person who is fully trained.

	Personnel who travel to the North Slope to perform physical work regardless of location while being escorted at all times by a person who is fully trained.

- 2. Training applies to all location(s) where staying or working. First time workers need to email completion certificate to: <a href="mailto:akhseorientation@conocophillips.com">akhseorientation@conocophillips.com</a> (replaces Welcome to Alpine and Kuparuk Camp Orientation)
- 3. Workers who will be in the production facility or on/near drill sites in the applicable field(s)
- 4. Required for Kuparuk Field; substitute for this requirement is NPR-A training.
- 5. Workers traveling to or working in the NPR-A.
- 6. Initial NSTC Card will suffice until frequency refresher date is due.
- 7. North Slope personnel using the ConocoPhillips radio system.
- 8. Personnel requiring access to Alpine Runway
- Workers and supervisors who issue, initiate, work under, or oversee permitted work. Training is provided by Alaska Safety Alliance (ASA).
- 10. North Slope based personnel except those with a higher EIP Worker, Individual Worker or Designated Worker level of training.
- 11. Individuals working under Energy Isolation Procedures. Contractors = Annual Refresher, COPA = 3-year Refresher
- 12. Workers who are directly involved with inspection, maintenance, or operation of oil storage and transfer equipment.
- 13. Workers with physical or logical access to systems connected to Operations Technology (OT) systems. Includes personnel performing work associated with the Process Control Systems (*Network, OT, BPCS, Metering, SIS, Fire and Gas*).
